

Scheduled Travel Restrictions

July 25 - July 31, 2010

(Please note that schedules listed are subject to change due to inclement weather)

LONG-TERM CLOSURES

On Interstate 80, the east and westbound Donner Rest Areas will be closed from **May 3, 2010 to May 1, 2011**. A contractor is scheduled to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

On Interstate 80, the westbound connector to the CHP Truck Inspection Facility will be closed from **May 10 to July 31**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28(Placer County) in Kings Beach: Work has resumed on a \$46 million environmental improvement project to reconstruct drainage facilities and improve the road surface. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011.

July 26 – 30

On State Route 28 (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Estates Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. Monday through 6 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled for drainage work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work has begun on a \$31 million project to add bus/carpool lanes to U.S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011.

July 25 - 31

On U.S. Highway 50 from the El Dorado/Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7**

a.m. (9 a.m. Saturday) Sunday through Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work has begun on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems.

July 25 – 30

On Interstate 80 from State Route 20 to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80(Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2011. **No traffic-interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Lake to Donner Pass Road in Truckee: Work continues on the \$70 million Donner I construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems, construction of a westbound truck-climbing lane from Donner Pass Road to the Donner Lake Interchange and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2010.

July 26 – 29

On Interstate 80 from the Trout Creek under-crossing to the Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from **4 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Boca to the Nevada State line: Work continues on the \$73 million Truckee River Canyon construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems, construction of a westbound truck-climbing lane from Donner Pass Road to the Donner Lake Interchange and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2010.

July 25 – 31

On Interstate 80 from Floriston to the Nevada State line: Motorists can expect lane availability as follows and may be subject to change without prior notification:

EASTBOUND / 2 LANES AVAILABLE ON:

- o THURSDAY - 1PM TO 6PM
- o FRIDAY - 1PM TO 10PM
- o SATURDAY - 9AM TO 9PM

ONE EASTBOUND LANE AVAILABLE AT ALL OTHER TIMES

WESTBOUND / 2 LANES AVAILABLE ON:

- o SUNDAY - 8AM TO 7PM

ONE WESTBOUND LANE AVAILABLE AT ALL OTHER TIMES

State Route 89 (Placer County) from the Tahoe City 'Y' to north of Squaw Valley: Work has started on a \$13 million project to improve the treatment of storm-water runoff and widen and resurface the highway. Completion is expected in 2010.

July 26 - 30

On State Route 89 between Alpine Meadows Road to Squaw Valley Road: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 lane and right shoulders closed from **7 a.m. Monday through noon Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Gold Flat Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Coyote Street to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Excelsior Road to the Bear River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (10 a.m. Friday) Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Agatam Avenue East to Brassie Avenue: Motorists can expect various lane closures from **6 a.m. to noon Tuesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do overhead utility work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado County) at Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail installation.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do brush work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from State Route 193 to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lanes closed from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Crystal Boulevard to Union Mine: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **midnight Monday through 11:45 p.m. Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Luther Road to Nevada Street: Motorists can expect the southbound #2 lane closed from **8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do underground utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Cottage Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect the northbound #2 lane closed from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to construct a turn pocket.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from the Yuba Pass to the Plumas County line: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 lane closed from **6:45 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Downieville Maintenance Station: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch cleaning.

US Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Wrights Lake Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail installation.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 267 to the Polaris under-crossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from the Alpine County line to US Highway 50: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from Sidehill Viaduct to 4 Ring Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from Rubicon Drive to the Placer County line: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 from **7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at Squaw Valley Road: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 lanes from **6:45 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do paving.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Hennes Pass Road to the Plumas County line: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 from **6:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to Auburn Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do crack sealing.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Main Street to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Rusty Road to Stewart Way: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 lane closures from **midnight Monday through 9 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.
